- 1. We believe that every word in the original writings is inspired by God and is without error. It is accurate in all matters to which it speaks. The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the foundation of the faith and practice of Oklahoma Bible Academy (II Tim. 3:16; II Pet. 1:21). We believe the Bible to be the center of true Christian unity and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds and opinions shall be tried.
- 2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Gen. 1:1, John 10:30, John 10:37-38)
- 3. We believe The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity. He regenerates, indwells, baptizes, and seals all believers in Christ and empowers those yielded to God. (Matt. 28:19; John 3:3-7; Titus 3:5; I Cor. 6:19; Rom. 8:9; I Cor. 2:12; 12:13; Eph. 4:30; Col. 3:14)

We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (Is. 7:14, Matt 1:23, Luke 1:35, Heb. 4:15, Heb. 7:25, John 2:11, Heb. 9:12, Eph. 1:7, Col. 1:14, John 11:25, Acts 1:11, Rev. 19:11-16)
- 5. We believe that man was created in the image and likeness of God. In Adam, all mankind fell into sin with the result that all men are sinners. Men are justly condemned to eternal judgment and can do nothing to merit salvation. (Rom. 2:2,3,5; Eph. 2:8,9; Gen. 1:27, 9:6; Rom. 5:12; 3:23; Eph. 2:1)
- 6. We believe that salvation is given to those chosen by God and drawn to Christ by the Holy Spirit. The only means to their salvation is belief in Christ's substitutionary death and resurrection.
